

Auburn Springs Homeowners Association Pool Safety Guidelines

The use of the community pool center is exclusively for residents in good standing of the Auburn Springs Homeowners Association and their guests.

Hours of operation:

8:00 AM - 10:00 PM 7 days a week

Noise disturbances after these hours should be reported to the police.

Any violation to the safety guidelines or other pool rules will subject violations to one or all of the following sanctions: (i) removal from the pool area, (ii) suspension of pool privileges for 60 days (iii) a fine up to \$500.00, as determined by the Board in its reasonable discretion.

- All persons swim and use the pool at their own risk. There is no lifeguard on duty.
- Caution: Water in the pool is shallow. NO DIVING ALLOWED.
- Entry to the pool shall be through the gates with an active key fob only. Any other entry gained is strictly prohibited. The gates must be closed and locked at all times.
- It is the responsibility of each resident to insure that children (under six years of age) are supervised at all times by a designated, responsible adult (eighteen years or older) member in good standing while the in the pool area.
- NO GLASS. Only unbreakable containers are permitted in the pool area.
- Pets, bicycles, roller skates and skateboarding are not permitted in the pool.
- Running, tag games, "cannon-balling" or boisterous play of any kind is not permitted in the pool area.
- Battery powered radios are to be kept at a level that does not disturb the atmosphere of the pool area.
- Do not throw items such as rocks, nails, marbles, coins and the like into the pool. Use of floating tubes, rafts, and toys must not interfere with the use of the pool by others.

•	Usual and customary swimming attire is required. Cut-offs or blue jeans do not meet this requirement.

- Owners interested in scheduling an event at the pool area shall register the party with the Management Company during normal business hours. A minimum of two weeks advance notice is required. All clean up shall be the responsibility of the resident requesting the reservation. An adult (eighteen years or older) member of the residents family must accompany guest.
- Use lifesaving equipment in and about the pool area in an emergency only. These are not play items and need to be maintained for everyone's safety.
- No food or beverages of any kind are allowed in the pool.
- The gate between the pool and the playground must be kept closed and locked at all times.
- IN CASE OF EMERGENCY CALL 911.
